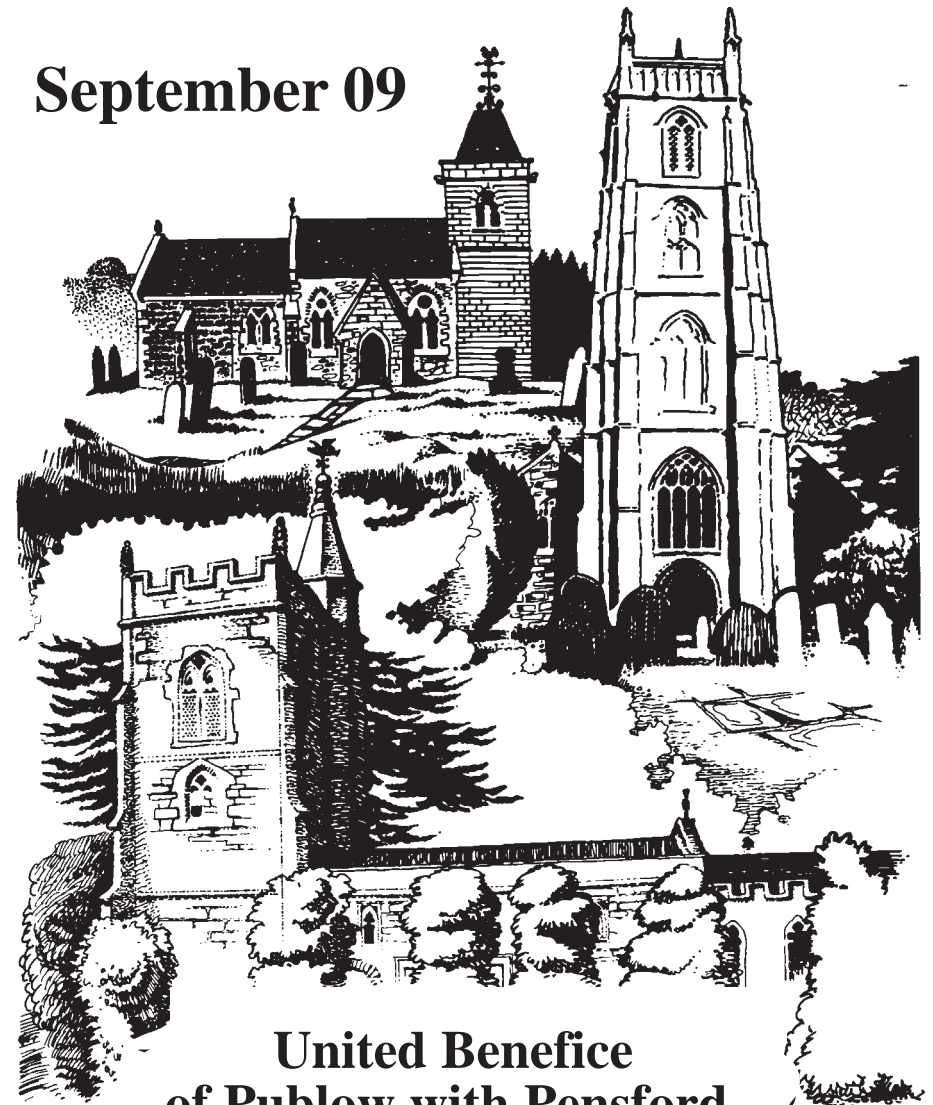

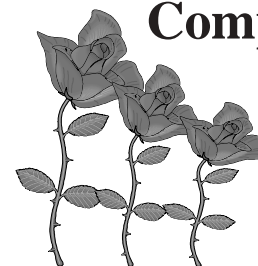

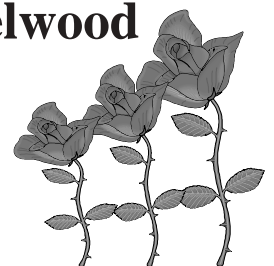

Dear all,

September. The year in comfortable middle age: impetuous spring, a distant memory; failing winter, still to come. A time of change; not the bursting change of March, but a gentle mellowing.

Change is a strange thing. With no change at all, there would be no time: everything frozen, forever. Change brings loss, if only the loss of today to yesterday. Change also allows hope.

1100 years ago, Athelm, a monk of Glastonbury Abbey, became the first Bishop of Wells. A lot of water has flowed along the Chew since then. What changes has the river seen? The Norman bishops ousting the Saxon. The monks of Bath and the canons of Wells jostling for the See, with the Bishop swapping seats faster than children playing musical chairs; Pope Innocent IV calling it a dead heat, forming Bath & Wells. The Lollardy heresy, with Pensford's priest excommunicated. The dissolution of the monasteries; a huge change for the people of our parishes, with their connections with the monasteries at Bath, Keynsham, and Glastonbury. The Quakers, hiding from persecution here. The Methodists, with John Wesley himself preaching in Pensford (20 October, 1775, if you're curious; a Wednesday); and so on, and so on...

Just names and dates. Hard to connect with, perhaps, but think what impact some of those changes had on people's lives: deeply held beliefs, habits of practice, everyday certainties, gone.

We are of course in a period of (somewhat smaller-scale) change in the Benefice at the moment. Our third Rector in as many years will hopefully be arriving later this year; she or he will doubtless make changes. And the Archdeacon told us at a recent open meeting that this will be the last Rector contracted for only a few hours a week, without pay; after that, there will be a full-time salaried priest, but one with additional duties beyond the Benefice. On current plans – we shall see how it turns out.

Good or bad, change is inevitable. Except from pay-and-display machines.

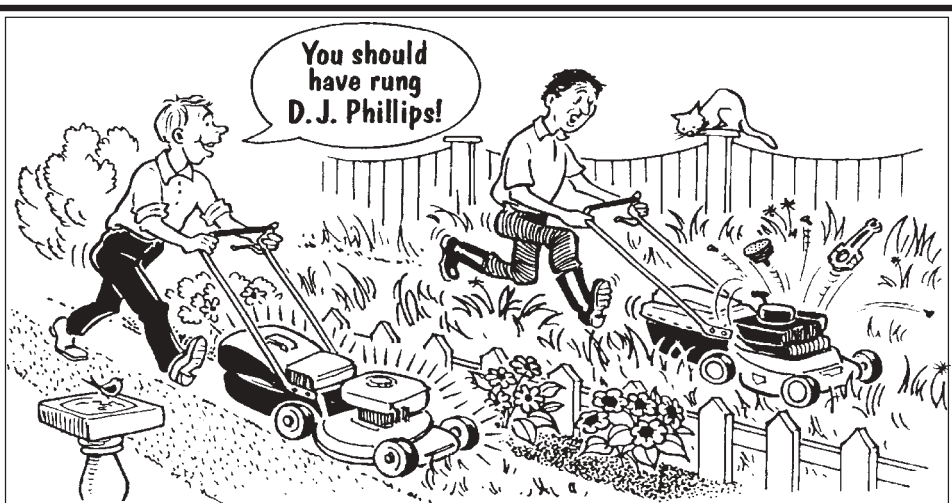

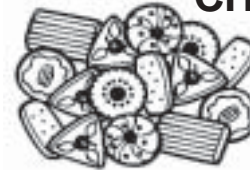
